Dr. Mohamed, Secretary presented the report of activities carried out during the previous year. He said that there has been an increase in the membership of MBAI and the number has gone up from 695 in 2013-14 to 714 in 2014-15.

Dr. Mohamed explained the Small Grant Pragramme which is being launched as per the decisions taken in the last GB. The grant is awarded by Marine Biological Association of India to encourage and reward brilliant young graduate students to pursue small and significant research activity, related to marine ecosystem/fisheries.

#### Agenda-3: Treasurer's Report

Treasurer, Dr. Somy Kuriakose, presented the Audited report for the period 2013-2014. The audited accounts were passed unanimously by the house. The accounts for the year 2014-2015 are pending with the Auditors.

### **Agenda-4: Editor's Report**

Dr. Zacharia, Editor presented the Editor's report. In the report he stated that in 2014 **Volume 56 Issue (1&2) has been published** 

Volume 56 Issue 1 is special publication on the proceedings of Asia Regional Symposium on Ecosystem Approaches to the Management and Conservation of Fisheries and Marine Biodiversity in the Asia Region IUCN-Mangrove for the future. This volume contains 17 papers and Volume 56 Issue 2, contains 15 papers. Volume 57 (1) for the period January-June 2015 is likely to be released in the coming June 2015. Now, 7 pre-press articles are ready for this issue, 4 revised papers are in editorial committee for editing.

From January 2014 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015 we have received total 51 papers in JMBAI. 10 papers were rejected and there are 41 manuscripts in various stages of processing.
